

What is Orphan Hosting?

A 5 week summer or winter event where you welcome an orphan child from Latvia, Ukraine or China into your home. Most of these children have never had a normal family life. You help change that! You show them what a caring family is all about, to be loved without conditions. You might be surprised at whose life is changed the most.

Who Can Host?

The primary requirement is your desire to be good host parents. Married couples and single female parents may apply to host, but must be at least 25 years old. There is no upper age limit. Host families are expected to complete an Application to Host, which can be found on our website www.p143.org.

What are the Requirements?

It is simple. All host parents must complete clearance and background checks. A home safety visit is conducted by a Licensed Social Worker who will examine the general environment for any hazards that might not be suitable to accommodate a host child.

Can I Host from Any State?

Hosting is open only to U.S. based families, because the children are provided Visas to visit the USA only. We are open to families anywhere in the USA. We've even had a host family from North Pole, Alaska!

What is Project 143?

Project 143 is similar to a foreign exchange program only for orphan children. We connect orphans with U.S. based families, where orphan children come and live as a family member for 5 weeks. Something they have never experienced. We are passionate about orphans and giving them – HOPE and doing all we can to save just ONE more child. P143 is named for its focus; serving 143+ million orphans worldwide.
